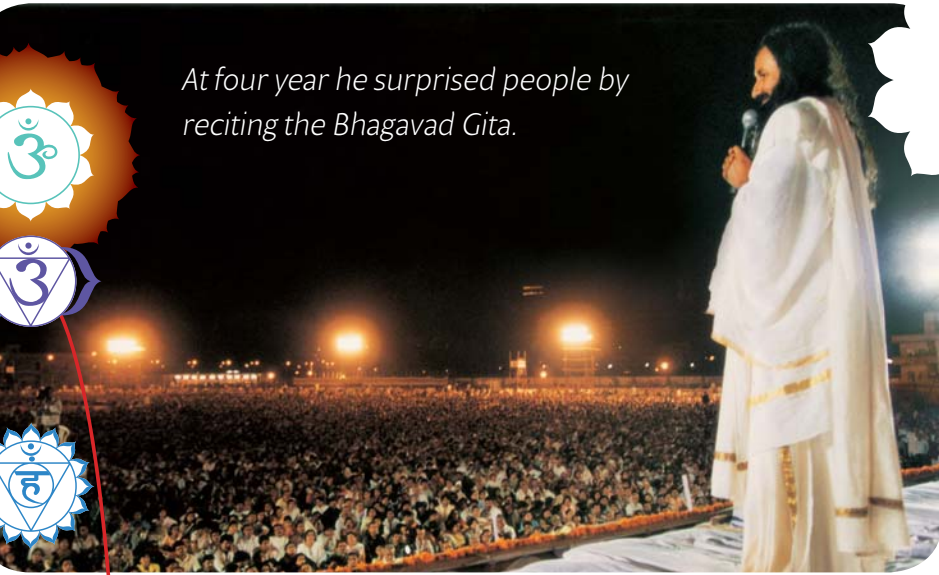

WHO IS SRI SRI RAVI SHANKAR?

Occasionally a time is blessed with One of extraordinary brilliance and compassion who comes out to teach among the people. Such a presence abundantly uplifts those of that time and those of generations to come. History records the impact of such Ones as Christ, Buddha, Loa-tzu, Krishna, Adi Shankara, Mahavir and others of diverse times and places whose names are less known today. With his visit we herald the living presence of such a One.

He is addressed by various names: Guruji, Swamiji, Babaji. He has no care for titles. Many simply call him Punditji (Revered wise one). His full name is Sri Sri Ravi Shankar.

A spiritual Master of exquisite grace and rarity, he embodies at once the love of Jesus, the silence of Buddha, the playfulness of Krishna and the wis-

dom of Adi Shankara. Miracles abound in the life of anyone whose heart he touches.

For his numerous initiatives Sri Sri was nominated several times for the Nobel Peace Prize.

Establishing Art of Living Foundation

In 1982 Sri Sri Ravi Shankar established the Art of Living Foundation. Today, his foundation is considered to be one of the largest volunteer-based educational and humanitarian organizations in the world. Represented in more than 150 countries, Art of Living offers sustainable solutions to a wide range of problems of individuals and societies. In 1997, he founded the International Association for Human Values (IAHV), along with Dalai Lama and a number of other people.



THE PHILOSOPHY OF SRI SRI RAVI SHANKAR

Sri Sri Ravi Shankar teaches people to replace hatred and suffering with love and wisdom. He spreads the message of universal love, peace and brotherhood throughout the world.

He aims at promoting spirituality amongst people and making them realize that there is goodness in every individual.
